## Motivation Letter

My official name is Ying-Chii Chen, English name is Cherry and Japanese name is 櫻子. I am the sixth year medical student of Chung Shan Medical University. I am looking forward to apply for the exchange program of the well established Tokyo Medical University, a famous medical university equipped with latest medical technology and abundance of medical resources, which I have heard its name since long time ago.

Being a doctor is my dream since I was a high school student. Before that time, my first dream was a translator due to my language ability of both Chinese and Japanese. However, after I realized that I can help more people by being a doctor, especially caring for my beloved family and all others' health, I started to work hard toward the goal. Besides, my younger sister has poor health condition since she was born, I made up my mind to become a doctor so that I can help her in the future.

I was born in Japan because my mother is Japanese. Though I came back to Taiwan afterward due to my father's family, I fly to Japan every year to visit my mother's family there. During those nine years from elementary school to junior high school, I went to the local school in Japan for one month after Taiwan school semester ends every year, so I have many Japanese friends. Most important of all, I have experienced the differences between Taiwanese school and Japanese school.

After I became a medical student of Chung Shan Medical University, I joined an international students' association called "Asian Medical Students' Association (AMSA)". Since then, I had organized and attended numerous activities of AMSA as the regional chairperson of Taiwan, such as annual conferences held every summer and winter in different countries where medical students from all around the world gather together. Thanks to AMSA, I made many new friends from many countries such as Hong Kong, Malaysia, Singapore, Korea, Australia, Thailand...etc and especially Japanese medical students, including students of Tokyo Medical University. I learned a lot from them about Japanese medical education system and life of being a medical student in Japan. Furthermore, when I go visit my family in Japan every year, I often visit the local hospital. The advanced working environment and the considerate way doctors and nurses approach patients impressed me a lot. At that time, I wished that if I have the chance to experience the life as a Japanese medical student, I would definitely work hard for it.

Fortunately, I got the chance to go to Tokyo Medical University Hospital for exchange program from March, 2014 for about 2 months. I was very nervous at first, but all the teachers, doctors, nurses or students there are very nice to me, make me feel like being at home. I went to 5 departments which are emergency medicine, orthopedic surgery, anesthesiology, dermatology, and OB/GYN department. Thanks to everyone I met at Tokyo Medical University Hospital, I really learned a lot during those days, not only knowledge but also some bedside procedures, surgical techniques and ways of how

to approach patients. Furthermore, the extremely clean environment inside the hospital, advanced equipments and manners of workers and patients impressed me a lot. I also learned the differences of hospital and medical education system between Japan and Taiwan, which were more than I have imagined.

This time, I heard that there is another chance to apply for the exchange program, I really had lots of precious experience here. I wished to go again. If I get the chance to visit Tokyo Medical University again, I will do the same things that I didn't do this time. I will do my best to learn more about Japanese medical education system and life of being a medical student in Japan. I will also learn what to prepare for the national and cultural advantage, I wish to learn more about Japanese medical knowledge, technology,



写真は、医局でもみじまんじゅうを食べているところと小島先生に糸結びを習っているところです。




## 交換留学生
